6th – 8th Grade After-School Program
Through a partnership with the City of Kettering, transportation is provided from both middle schools to both after-school sites. Students can ride from KMS to Christ United Church every Monday and Wednesday. Students can ride from KMS and VB to Emmanuel Lutheran Church on Tuesday.

Pick up is at 3:40 p.m. in the west parking lot of KMS or in the southeast parking lot of VB (near the cafeteria). Students can look for the City of Kettering van.

Parents must pick up their child at the end of the program at 5:30 p.m. at Christ Church or Emmanuel Lutheran Church. For transportation just follow these simple steps:

1. Go to the information desk at the Kettering Recreation Complex.
2. Complete the transportation permission slip.
3. Pay your \$20 membership fee. (scholarships for transportation are available)
4. Get a picture I.D.
5. Get ready to have fun!
